From the Pastors Desk

The Habit of Looking Forward

Dear brothers and sister in Christ. Every now and again we hear someone saying “Those were the good old days. How I wish it can be like that again!” When people say this they are being nostalgic about their past. When we are nostalgic we tend to look back over our past. Sadly, it happens that some of us get stuck in the past. The reason is twofold:

- Firstly, we are stuck in the past when we cling to the way that things once were. We do not want those things to change because we tend to like our old familiar habits and traditions. Change can be scary because we do not know how things are going to change. We fail to believe that the future that God intends for us can be better than the past.
- Secondly, we live in the past when we allow hurtful-memories from the past to keep us captive. For instance when another person broke you down by told you that you will never be good enough. Or maybe you have done something in the past that you feel ashamed of or guilty for. So we let other people's past words and our past actions define us! If this happens, we fail to see God's beautiful future that God has planned for us.

God does not want that we remain stuck in the past. Paul writes in Philippians 3 verse 13b the following: “But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining towards what is ahead”. Paul is encouraging us to look forward. When we drive our cars, we look forward, through the windscreen. We cannot drive our cars by just looking back through the rear-view mirror. If we would, we would make an accident and come to a standstill. Rather we use our rear-view-mirror to help us in reversing and to safely change lanes.

We should use our past as a rear-view-mirror. Looking back over our past, we can see what God has done for us. We see that God remains faithful and constant. Looking back over the past can help us to see, when we are drifting away from God.

Paul is encouraging us to look forward. Through looking forward to God, we grow in our relationship with God. Growth means change! God shapes and moulds us through his love. Through looking forward to God, we turn to God to guide, lead and care for us. God then becomes the centre of our life. Looking forwards to God, we are reminded that God loves us and accepts us just as we are! In other words, we are good enough for him and nothing in our past, in the present nor anything in the future can separate us from His love.

God wants that we turn our head forward, look through the windscreen, and enjoy our life because God's future is much more beautiful than your past.

Was für eine heilsame Alternative zu dem, was unsere Welt normalerweise prägt!
